







Latest Release from Vecima Networks

The latest release of the Vecima Telematics System will be completed on Thursday, **September 18, 2025**. Please see below for a brief description of the enhancements included in this release.

Feature	Description
<p>Vehicle Tab Improvements</p> 	<p>The columns that appear in the Vehicle Tab are now customizable.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Additional columns are now available for viewing, including vehicle make, model, year and license plate. • You may select which columns you want to view and which you want to hide. • The visible columns may be arranged in the order you prefer. • Your preferences will be remembered the next time you log in.
<p>Remember Filters on Map View</p> 	<p>In the Map View, your filtering selections (accessible in the left side pull out menu) are now remembered. When you navigate away from the map it will retain the filter selections, and the Map View will appear the same when you return.</p>

<p>Idle Reporting Improvements</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Idle Time</p> </div>	<p>The Idle Time* report now supports up to 5 years of historical data reporting.</p> <p>Both on-demand and scheduled Idle Time reports may now have their output set to a flat-file tabular format, so that the data may be easily imported into a spreadsheet for further analysis.</p> <p><i>* Please note that Idle Time with Map will support historical data in the near future.</i></p>
