The latest release of the Contigo System was completed on Friday August 21, 2009.

Please see below for a brief description of the enhancements included in this release.

Feature	Description
Dispatch and Navigation	This exciting release features the integration of the Contigo System with in-vehicle personal navigation devices, providing the ability to send jobs and messages to drivers. Features include:
	 Support for Garmin[™] nuvi 255/255w, nüvi 350/360 and StreetPilot C340 units connected to the Contigo 6100 beacon.
	 Send Jobs and monitor status in real-time (acknowledged, enroute, estimated time of arrival, done).
	• Exchange text messages with the driver.
	• View, send, reassign and reorder a vehicle's jobs from a map.
	Choose destinations using landmarks, address, map-click and even Latitude/Longitude.
	• Provide the driver with turn-by turn directions on the Garmin unit.

Feature	Description
DEX API: Ignition On and Off Events available	Ignition On and Ignition Off events are now available through the Contigo DEX application programming interface, allowing you to track and display daily vehicle usage in your external application.
DEX API: Start and Stop Events available	Vehicle Start and Stop events are now available through the Contigo DEX application programming interface, allowing you to track vehicle usage and idle time in your external application.
Map View Enhancements	Map View Control Panel may be expanded or collapsed to reduce clutter and hide unneeded controls. The entire Control Panel may also be hidden to maximize the viewable map area.

In addition to the major features above, this release will also include bug fixes and other minor enhancements.
