




## Latest Release of the Contigo System

The latest release of the Contigo System occurred on Friday May 7, 2010.

Please see below for a brief description of the enhancements included in this release.

Feature	Description
<b>Configurable Start/Stop Duration</b>	<p>For fleet operators with slow moving vehicles, or vehicles that stop for very short periods of time, it's difficult to see the vehicle's starts and stops on reports and route logs. This new feature provides optional configuration settings for the Start and Stop scenario, allowing you to customize the speed at which starts and stops are generated, and the duration that a vehicle must be in motion, or stopped, in order to trigger the appropriate event.</p> 
<b>Dispatch and Message Alerts</b>	<p>When using the Dispatch and Navigation features of Contigo, dispatchers want to know when the status of jobs has changed, or when drivers send messages from their vehicle.</p> <p>In this release, you may optionally configure audible and visible alerts to notify you of these changes. The Dispatch tab will flash red, and your computer will provide a beeping sound.</p> 

Feature	Description
<b>Dispatch and Navigation: Street Address added to Job Description</b>	<p>Dispatchers want drivers to see the address of their destination appear on the Garmin PND.</p> <p>Now, when sending jobs from Landmarks, from a validated address, or even when clicking on the map, the address will be displayed in the Job Description field.</p> <p>You may modify the contents of the Job Description to suit your driver's needs up to a maximum of 55 characters.</p> <p>If the Landmark name and street address exceed the 55 character limit of the Job Description, the Landmark name will be truncated.</p> 

In addition to the major features above, this release also includes bug fixes and other minor enhancements.
