





Latest Release of the Contigo System

The latest release of the Contigo System was completed on Thursday December 6, 2012. Please see below for a brief description of the enhancements included in this release.

Important Notes

1. Recent updates to MapQuest require FlashPlayer 11.1+ to be installed in your browser for viewing maps in the portal. Please ensure that Flash is up to date on your system.

<p>GPS Fleet Tracker 1.0.3 for Mobile</p> 	<p>Version 1.0.3 of GPS Fleet Tracker is now available for iPhone and Android.</p> <p>The following new feature is supported:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Real time location updates <p>In previous versions, the user was required to tap "refresh" to view the latest map updates. With version 1.0.3, map updates occur automatically in real time.</p> <p>Available from the iTunes App Store and Google Play. Feature	Description
Network Interface Repair	<p>A long-term fix was applied for the previously reported hardware issue that was causing intermittent connectivity issues for the web portal.</p> <p>In addition, new monitoring capabilities have been added to the Contigo systems to allow for more effective troubleshooting in the future.</p>
6450 Beacon Replacement Tool	<p>This release allows partners to easily replace older or defective beacons with the new 6450 (OBDII) beacon, while retaining configuration details and historical data from the previous device.</p>
Monitored Events for the 6450	<p>Partners will now be able to take advantage of the Monitoring capabilities of the Contigo portal for customers using the 6450 (OBDII) beacon.</p>
Changes to Beacon Registration Process – Inactive SIMs	<p>In the future, US-based beacons will be shipped to partners with inactive SIM cards. The registration process has been streamlined to allow beacons to be activated and then registered in the same session.</p>

In addition to the features above, this release will also include bug fixes and other minor enhancements.
