Latest Release of the Contigo System

The latest release of the Contigo System was completed on Thursday January 30, 2014. Please see below for a brief description of the enhancements included in this release.

Important Notes

- 1. If you continue to use Flash technology for viewing maps in the portal, FlashPlayer 11.1+ is required to be installed in your browser. Please ensure that Flash is up to date on your system.
- 2. To ensure that all portal features function correctly, it is recommended that you clear your browser's cookies and cache. For assistance, please visit http://www.contigo.com/clear_browser_cache.html.

Feature Description Map View has been enhanced to include **Map View Enhancements** additional vehicle state information for the events being displayed on the map. 1. A Green halo indicates that the vehicle is AUTO BEST FIT currently moving. If the direction can be determined from the most recent event, then an arrow is included on the icon DE-CLUTTER (BETA) indicating the direction of movement. П 2. A Yellow halo indicates that the vehicle is not moving, but the ignition is currently ~ turned on. 3. A Red halo indicates that the vehicle is not moving, and the ignition is off. These state indicators are toggled using the "Display Item State" checkbox on the right side of the Map View window. * Note that JavaScript maps must be enabled for this feature to appear in Map View.

The map is now displayed above the event data table, allowing additional information to be displayed (including the new Driver ID information).
