


Latest Release of the Contigo System

The latest release of the Contigo System will be completed on Thursday July 31, 2014. Please see below for a brief description of the enhancements included in this release.

Important Notes

1. If you continue to use Flash technology for viewing maps in the portal, FlashPlayer 11.1+ is required to be installed in your browser. Please ensure that Flash is up to date on your system.
2. To ensure that all portal features function correctly, it is recommended that you clear your browser's cookies and cache. For assistance, please visit http://www.contigo.com/clear_browser_cache.html.

Feature	Description
<p>Power Savings Options for 65xx Beacons</p> 	<p>For 65xx models, there will be three options for limiting the power draw of the beacon on the vehicle battery. These may be selected in any combination according to your needs.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The beacon will automatically power off if the vehicle is not used for a given number of days. 2. The beacon will power off if the battery voltage falls below a set threshold. 3. The beacon will enter "napping mode" when the vehicle ignition is off, reducing message traffic and battery usage. <p>Power Savings settings will be controlled using the new Power Savings scenario.</p> <p>Please note that all currently deployed 65xx beacons are configured to power off after 7 days of inactivity. In order to represent this in the system, Power Savings scenarios will be created automatically for each 65xx beacon as of July 31, 2014.</p> <p>New 65xx beacons deployed after this date will need to be added to the Power Savings scenario if you wish to enable the power savings features.</p>
