Route Log in Map View Beta



The new Route Log in Map View varies somewhat from the existing Route Log Report. Locate events are displayed as a simple dot, whereas other events are highlighted by icons of different color representing the category of event: Red = Alarm events, Orange = Driver Behavior events, Dark Blue = Power related events, and Pale Blue = events pertaining to the Item State.

Up to <u>five</u> Route Log reports may be displayed at one time on different tabs within Map View. Only a single day of data is displayed (the default is the current day). By entering "report setup" a different date may be selected to display for that item.

If the Route Log is being viewed based upon the Driver ID rather than the vehicle, the driver must be <u>active</u> or no data will be returned for the report.
