





## Latest Release of the Contigo System

The latest release of the Contigo System will be completed on Wednesday July 22, 2015. Please see below for a brief description of the enhancements included in this release.

Please note that all updates will appear automatically in your portal (you are no longer required to clear your browser's cache).

Feature	Description
<p><b>Popular Stop Report</b></p> 	<p>This new report displays a heat map indicating locations where selected items have stopped for more than a specified duration.</p> <p>The items whose stops are displayed on the map are listed in a checklist, so that only selected items may be viewed. The report also provides details of all the stops in a tabular format similar to the regular stop report.</p> <p>If a popular stop has been indicated on the report output, the operator may view nearby landmarks, or create a new landmark on the map at that location.</p>
<p><b>Boundary Zones</b></p> 	<p>Many operators prefer to create circular zones that will generate events when items enter and exit the zone.</p> <p>This is now accomplished through the creation of a single circular zone scenario and selecting the new boundary zone option.</p>

Feature	Description
<p><b>Scenario List Navigation</b></p> 	<p>New options have been provided to allow operators to more easily navigate the list of scenarios.</p> <p>The scenario list can now be filtered by event type in addition to the existing filtering by department.</p>
<p><b>Bulk Service Plan Migration</b></p> 	<p>The dealer portal has been updated to allow administrators the ability to apply a service plan change to multiple items at the same time.</p>

In addition to the features above, this release will also include other minor bug fixes and enhancements.
