The latest release of the Contigo System will be completed on Tuesday August 9, 2016. Please see below for a brief description of the enhancements included in this release.

Feature	Description
Contigo 6601 HOS Device (BETA)	Contigo is pleased to add the 6601 HOS device to its expanding range of high-performance fleet beacons. Designed to plug directly into a J1939 port, the 6601 will support data received directly from the vehicle ECM, and will connect to ELD compliant handheld devices via Bluetooth. The limited Beta release of this product is designed to verify the existing fleet capabilities expected from all Contigo devices, including: Driver Behavior Events Idle Alerts Ignition Events Interval Tracking Posted Speed Alerts Power Cut Events Speed in Zones Speed Monitoring Start and Stop Events Zones – Circular and Polygon In the near future, the final product release will add ELD connectivity as well as support for J1939 DTC events.
GPS Fleet Tracker Updates	The GPS Fleet Tracker mobile app now supports two additional features: 1. Satellite Image maps may now be viewed on your handset. 2. Up to 50 vehicles may be viewed at once on the map.
