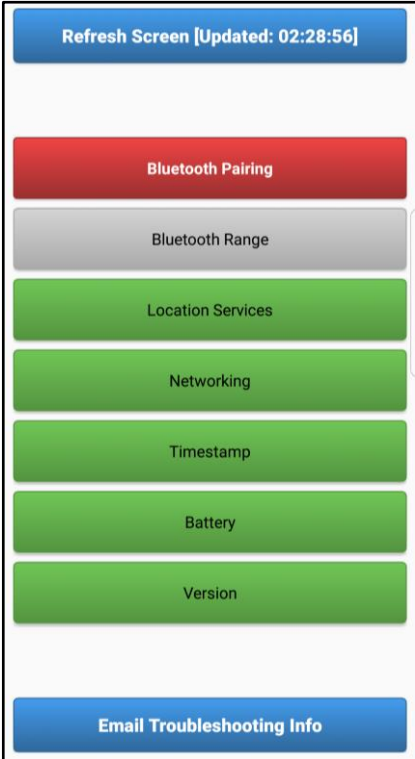



Latest Release of the Contigo System

The latest release of the Contigo System will be completed on Thursday November 30, 2017. Please see below for a brief description of the enhancements included in this release.

<p>Contigo ELD Solution</p>  	<p>The new FMCSA regulations for the use of Electronic Logging Devices (ELDs) for driver Hours of Service (HOS) logging come into effect on December 18, 2017.</p> <p>Our fully compliant ELD solution, combines the comprehensive fleet management capabilities of the Contigo 660x device with the e-Track Certified logging app from ATS Fleet Management Solutions.</p> <p>Since introducing the system, we have been hard at work performing extensive beta testing to ensure a smooth transition for drivers currently using paper logs.</p> <p>Specific updates in this release include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improved reliability of the Bluetooth interface. • The ability to rename the Bluetooth interface to match the vehicle name to prevent connecting with the wrong vehicle if parked close together. • Multiple administrators may now be enabled for the e-Track Client Portal. • The vehicle VIN is now more reliably reported by the 660x device.
